CONYERS MIDDLE SCHOOL DRESSCODE

SHIRTS/TOPS

Student Choice with exceptions below:

No halter tops, tank tops, Tshirts with suggestive, vulgar or obscene pictures or words, seethrough blouses, etc.

No part of the midriff or torso shall be visible.

No sleepwear shall be worn unless permitted for special events.



Student Choice with exceptions below:

Shorts/skirts no more than 3 inches above the knee.

Pants/shorts/skirts should not be form-fitting.

Leggings/jeggings must be worn with a shirt that extends to the knee area.

No hosiery in exchange for leggings.

No holes, rips, cuts or tears on jeans or other clothing articles.

(No longer allowed above or beneath the knee. Cloth coverings/patches do not meet compliance.)

BOTTOMS

Student Choice

with exceptions below:

SHOES/SOCKS

Students may not wear flip flops, slides or bedroom slippers unless permitted for special events.



ACCESSORIES (Hair)

Student Choice

with exceptions below:

No Bandanas / Hats / Hoodies unless permitted for special events.

Masks

Are required for all-day wear and must cover nose and mouth. Face shields may be worn "in addition" to masks.

** SPECIAL NOTICE **

Clothing/Accessories/Masks may not carry threatening, provocative or disruptive messages, symbols, advertisements for alcohol or tobacco products or messages that advocate the use of controlled substances.

Any clothing, hair color, jewelry, accessories, piercings, etc. determined by the principal or principal's designee to be of an extreme nature is prohibited.

(All dress code matters may be governed by the Principal or principal's designee.)

P.E.

Shirts / t-shirts

ORESS COD

- Shorts (no sagging allowed, no jeans, no dresses, etc.)
- Sweatpants
- Sweatshirts for cold days (no heavy jackets)
- Athletic Shoes (running or sport) (No slip-ons, heeled, Uggs, boots, slippers or flip-flops... Shoes with surround ankle material are strongly encouraged for adequate protection)
- Small bag to keep clothes organized
- ** PE Uniforms are required for all students enrolled in PE **

The following actions will be taken when students do not meet dress code compliance beginning the 1st day of school:

- 1st Offense: Student will report to main office with a pass and allowed to call home for parent assistance/change of clothing. If not corrected, student will be given alternative clothing provided by CMS if available. (If not available, student will be referred to CMS Admin for disciplinary action.)
- 2. **2nd Offense:** Same as 1st offense in addition to an Administrative Conference.
- **3. 3 OR more offenses:** Disciplinary action will be taken as outlined in the RCPS Parent Handbook.
